



## NORFOLK HAS TALENT - 2017 RULES FOR THOSE AUDITIONING:

**\* Norfolk County Residents & Employees Only!**

Contestants must be Norfolk County residents, or must work in Norfolk County and be able to provide proof of residence or employment. If you are in a group; i.e. band or choir, at least one member must be a citizen of Norfolk. If you are a post-secondary student away at school and you list a residence in Norfolk County as your primary residence, you may enter.

**\* Under 18? EVERY CONTESTANT** under the age of 18 must have permission from a parent or legal guardian to audition and must be accompanied by this parent or legal guardian at the audition location and NHT Showcase, if successful.

**\* Photo ID:** Everyone will require photo ID in order to attend the audition. A headshot will also be required, 8" x 10" black & white or colour will be accepted.

**\* Animal Acts:** Additional Paperwork Required! Any acts involving an animal must arrive at the audition with additional paperwork as outlined in Animal Acts portion.

**\* Length of Acts:** Any act that makes it through to the showcase will be limited to a time limit of 3 minutes maximum. If you exceed this time, you will be stopped and disqualified from the competition. Most professional talent shows limit their acts to 90 seconds. Auditions need only be about 90 seconds in length. You 'might' be stopped if your act exceeds this time. Choose the portion of your piece that highlights your abilities, i.e. singer find the song which best features your vocal range and abilities.

**\* Amateurs Only,** Professionals may not enter.

**\* Contestants** will be judged on both Talent and Performance.

**\* Performances** must be suitable for all ages.

**\* Judges** will not enter into discussion with parents or guardians of contestants.

**\* Winners** agree to have their picture and/or name published for promotional purposes.

**\* Organizers** reserve the right of final decision in matters not covered by the rules.

**\* The judges' decision is final.**
